The double threat

Fanaticism=

The desire to change others. Fanaticism is older than Islam, older than judaism, older than any state or government, or political system, older than any ideology or faith in the world.

Tolerance =

the ability to respect and accept the way we
and things are, things I can't change and
things that don't hurt me

Prejudice mirror

- Share a portrait cards. Find the person's story; who her or his is, jobs, housing, interests, family and so on. Write in the first person as if you were the person on the card. You have a maximum of seven minutes.
- Introduce other people in the story: "This person plays an important role in X's life - who is it?" "X hits this person a day - who is it?" (Friend, boss, relative, bus driver, supermarket cashier, etc.).



The Swedish curriculum
